Discussion openers

The role of discussion openers is to open the general discussion.

They can therefore only use 2 slides if any and have a limit of 2 minutes.

To make informed comments, they have read the paper before the presentation. They should share their most important comments and take advantage of coffee breaks and social events to give speakers their secondary comments.
